Now, therefore, this Agreement is made between Columbia and the Applicant as follows:

1. Applicant agrees to use natural gas as its primary energy source for heating the premises; and Columbia agrees to install a service line up to 100 feet at no cost to the Applicant.
2. It is mutually agreed that at the time the meter is placed Columbia will inspect the premises and if, at that time, Applicant does not utilize natural gas as per the intentions set forth herein, the meter will not be installed and gas turned on until \$926 has been collected.
