## **ROSEMARY AVENUE AREA**



As part of a Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government sewer project, Columbia Gas is required to relocate the natural gas distribution system in your neighborhood.

Please be prepared for digging and disruptions as we complete this work.

While this work is required, the replacement of pipe with state-of-the-art material will enhance the safety and reliability of natural gas service, will require less future maintenance and support amenities like fire pits, outdoor grills and pool heaters. This project includes the replacement of the main line, which runs under the street, sidewalk or easement; service lines that run from the main line to the natural gas meter on your property; and meters at each home or business.

## TRAFFIC IMPACTS

The project could result in temporary traffic restrictions or delays during working hours, although we will do our best to minimize disruptions. We also will work to maintain continued access to businesses, churches, schools and homes in the construction area.

### **WORK ZONE SAFETY**

We encourage all pedestrians and motorists traveling through work zones to exercise caution, reduce speed and obey flaggers and signs in the construction zone.
